Assistance for Dual Career Couples

Northeastern University understands that responding to the needs of dual career academic couples is key to recruiting and retaining an excellent faculty, and we offer a range of supports to assist dual career couples as they consider transitioning to Northeastern and the Boston area.

Northeastern is a member of New England HERC (Higher Education Recruitment Consortium), which provides information about faculty and staff positions at a wide range of academic and medical institutions in the New England region. Northeastern's HERC representative in Human Resources Management can help connect members of dual career couples to the resources of HERC, and is also available to review both opportunities and strategies for pursuing positions at Northeastern.

If the partner of a prospective faculty member is also seeking a faculty position, or may be interested in enrolling in a graduate program at Northeastern, a discussion with the chair of the prospective faculty candidate's hiring department or the dean of the hiring college is the first step. The earlier in the hiring process that the university becomes aware of a possible dual career situation involving two academic job searches, the more time the university has to evaluate the potential for matching the qualifications of the partner candidate with Northeastern's faculty hiring priorities and requirements.
