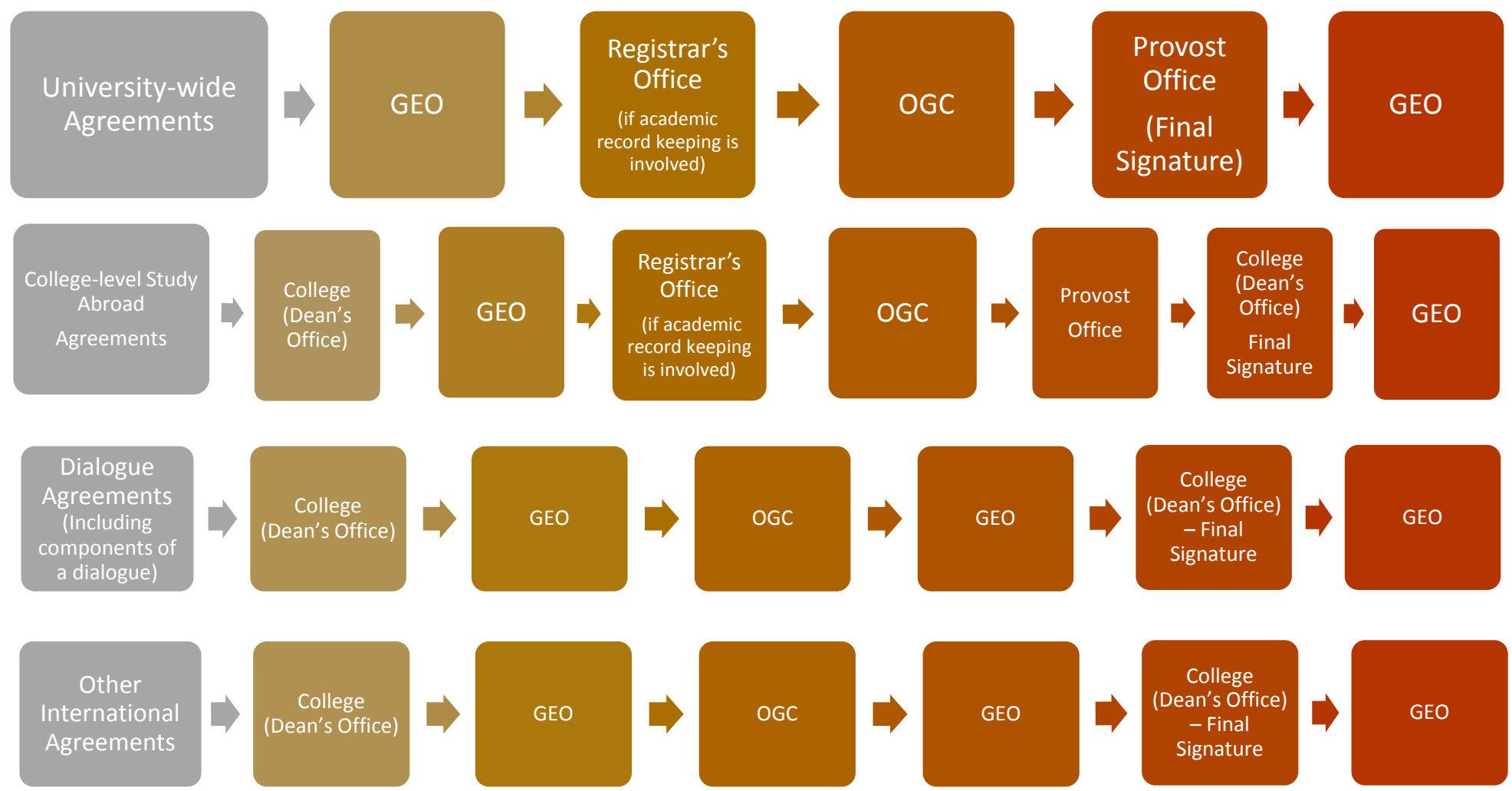
Study Abroad Strategies

- Convert “handshake deals” to formal agreements
- Eliminate 3-party vendors where it makes sense
- Re-examine current agreements and modify where it makes sense
- Work with NU faculty and units to define appropriate partner schools and curricular matching
- Work with units and co-op and other offices to leverage partnerships as it makes sense

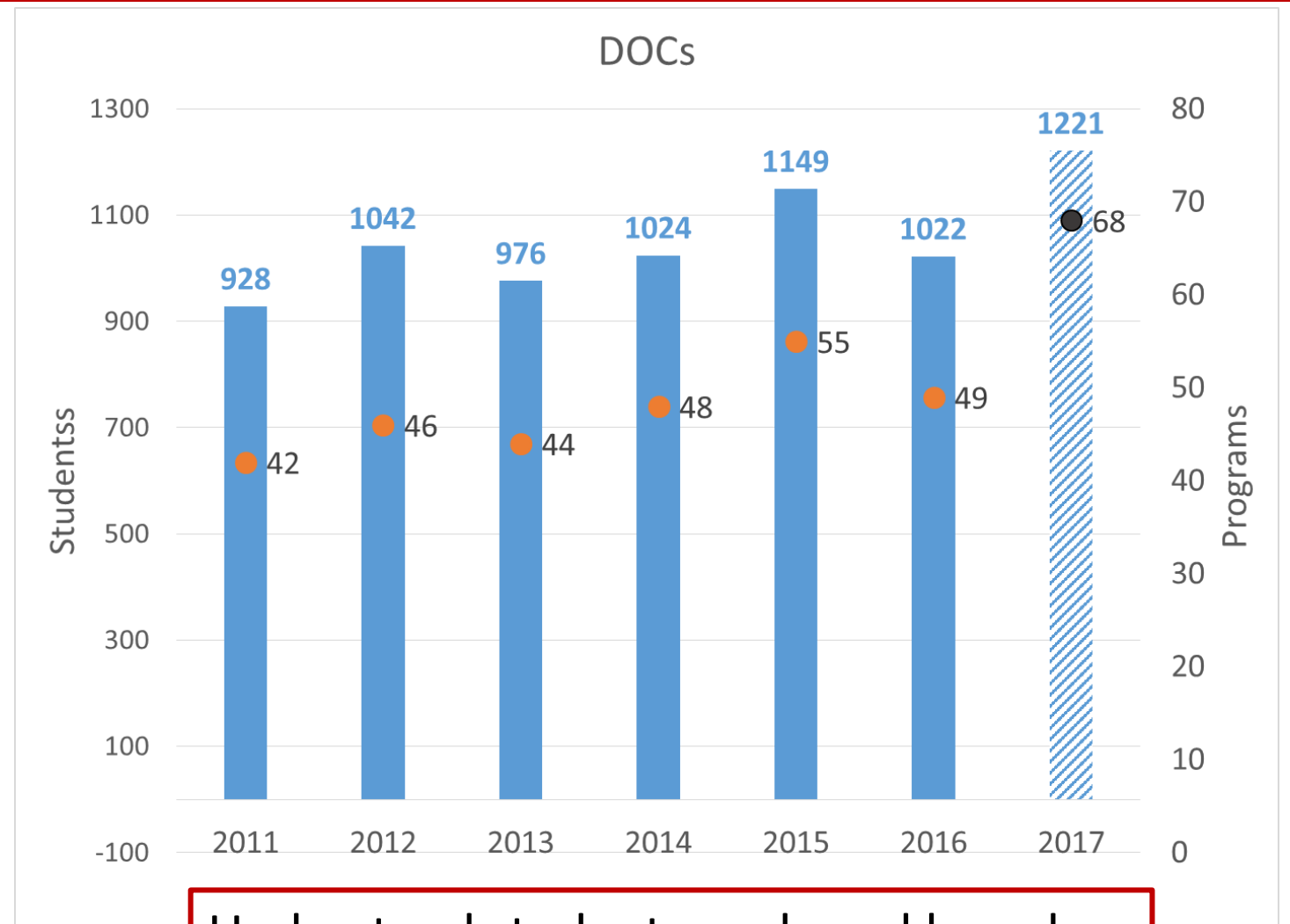
International Educational Agreements/Memorandum of Understanding Routing Process

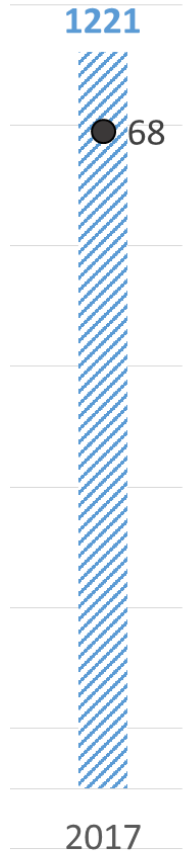
Proposal/Development Process

- Overall Approach
 - Departments and Colleges approve Curriculum
 - ISSAC determines S&H compliance, judges petitions
 - Faculty determines programing and budget
 - GEO enables as many students and programs as possible
- Transparent Processes – Web, reviewed in workshops
 - Working on Faculty Handbook
- Transparent Budget development
 - Policies
 - One-on-one development, adjustment, closure

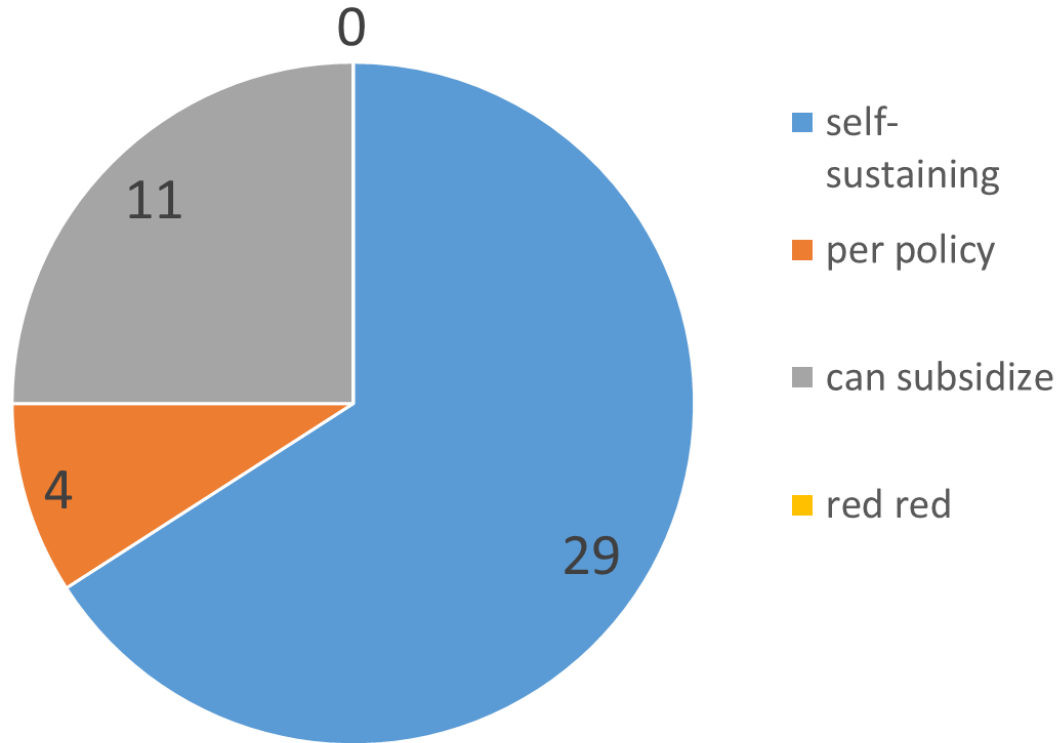


- Analyze how many dialogues are self-sustaining, can run per policy on reductions, can't run per policy* on reductions

- Explore non-Northeastern Student enrollment

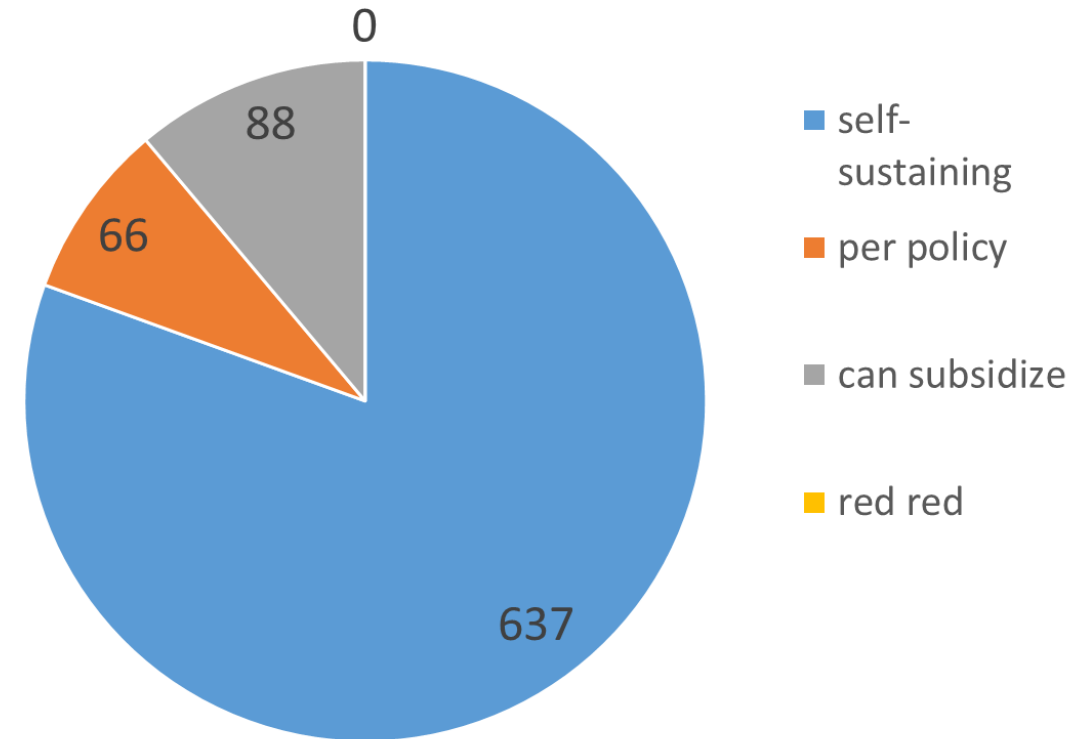
* First give up \$300/per student stipend and then \$600/per student GEO fee

as of 4:00 pm 1/31/17

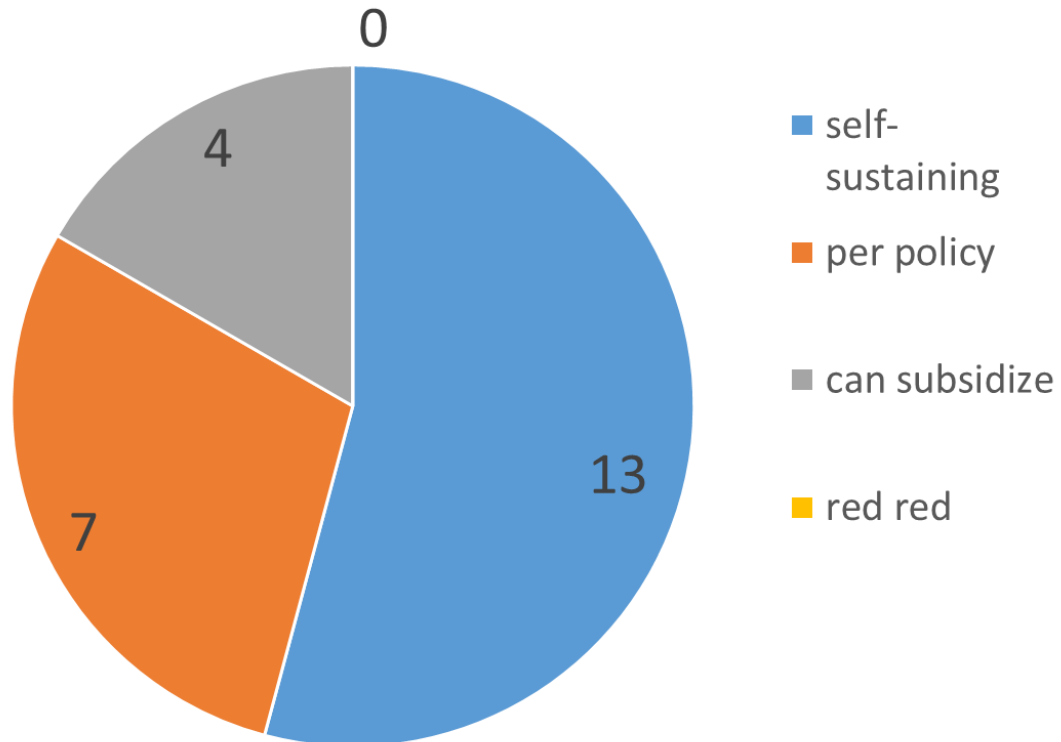


Students Summer 1
as of 4:00 pm 1/31/17

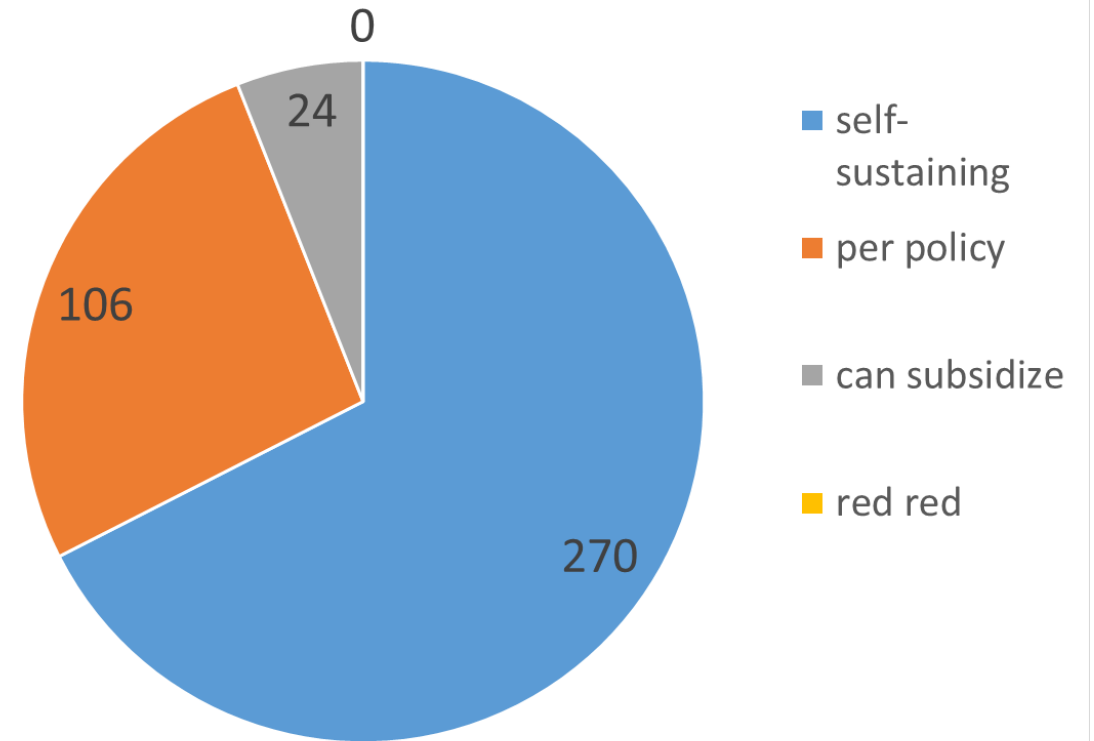

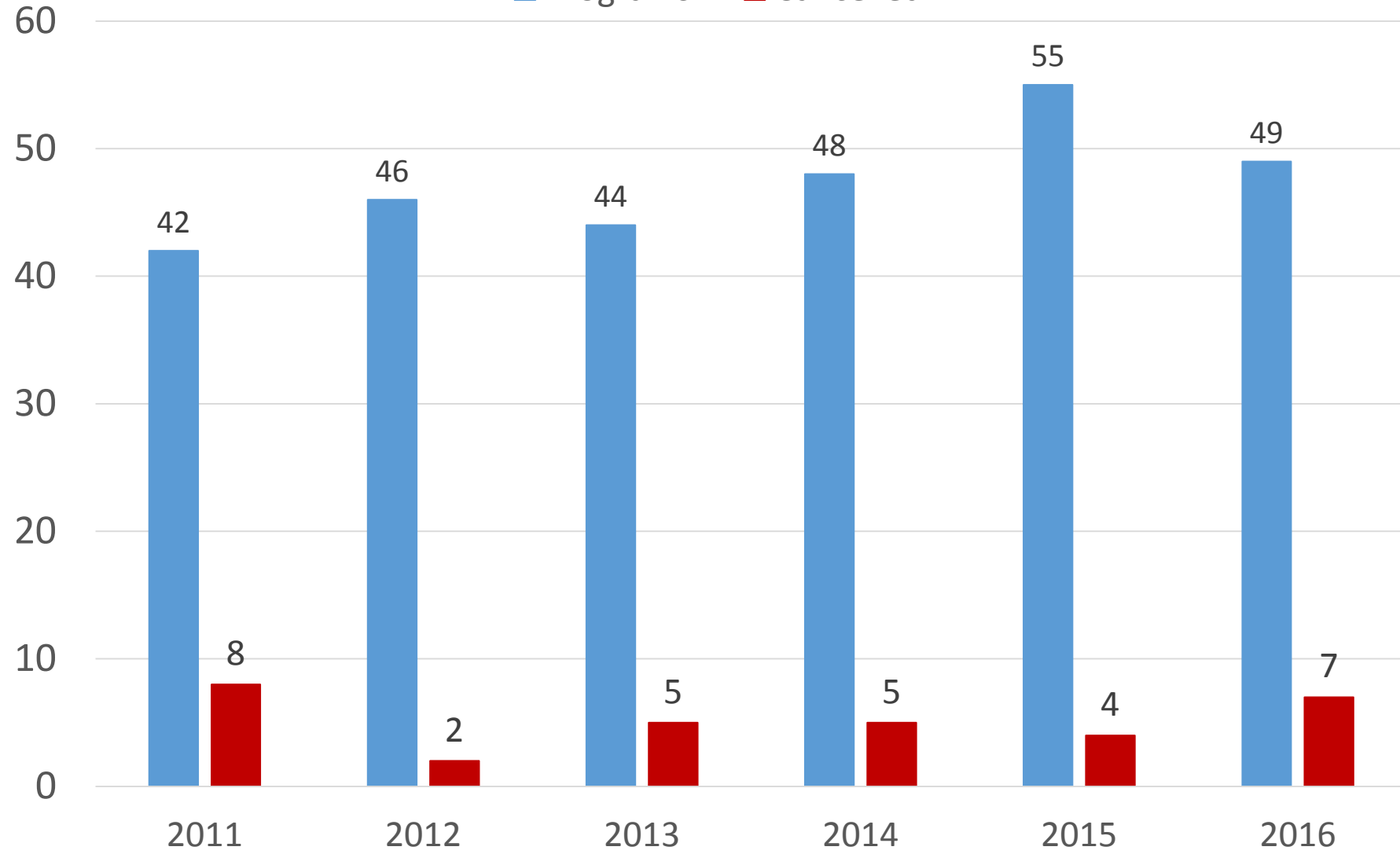

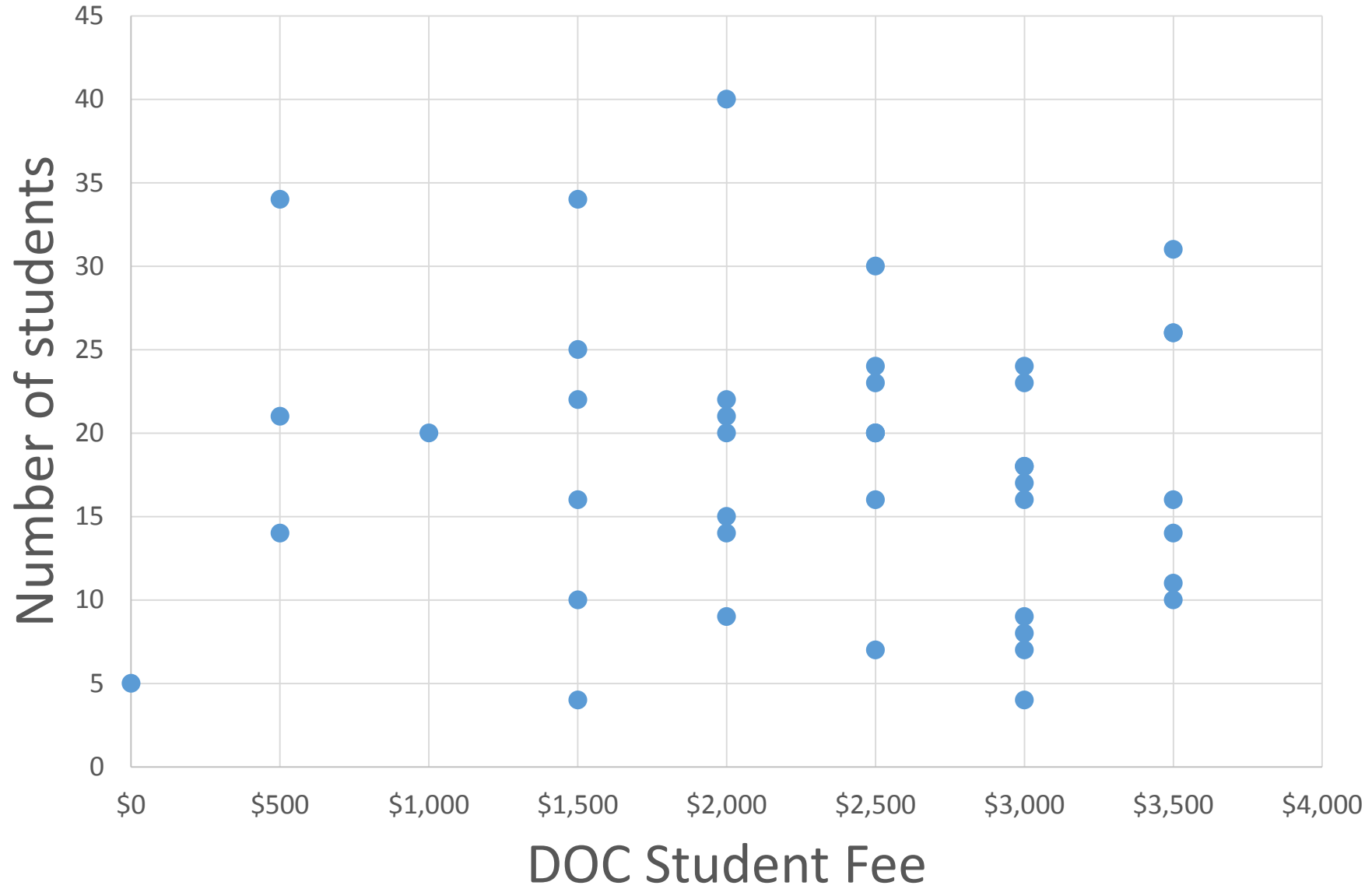
