Overview of President Aoun Presentation to the Faculty Senate

- The number of undergraduate (i.e. 18-22 year olds) students applying to colleges is decreasing
- Northeastern is particularly well positioned in this declining market:
 - We are experiential – value recognized
 - We are global – allows our students to be mobile and agile
 - We are the only university to have two comprehensive campuses – Mills College in Oakland and Boston
 - We are the only U.S. university to provide two degrees – dual – UK and US at NU London
- Our global university provides a depth of opportunities:
 - Research: opportunity to test new models in higher education
 - Roux Institute partnerships: work to determine the talent, solution, and research needs to impact society
 - Global campus aids in attracting diverse new talent, and providing new and exciting collaborations for our faculty
