Program Inactivation

Approved by Grad Council 1/11/2023, 11-0-0:

College	Program	Rationale
BCHS	CAGS-COPS : Counseling Psychology, CAGS	No longer serving the needs of our applicants following changes in accreditation and licensing regulations. No students are currently enrolled in the program.
BCHS	CAGS-ABA : Applied Behavior Analysis, CAGS	Board requirements are changing, and this program will no longer result in certification as a Board Certified Behavior Analyst. Students who are already enrolled in the program as of Fall 2023 will be able to complete the program, since all required courses are all part of the MS in ABA program which remains active.
