Amendments to the Faculty Senate Bylaws

Faculty Senate:

- *Must be distributed twice to the Senate and faculty prior to vote*
- *During Senate floor debate on an amendment proposal(s), Robert's Rules of Order apply for proposing amendments to any main motion, making advance notice not required*
- *A 2/3 affirmative vote of all Senators voting 'yea' or 'nay' in a roll-call vote*

Ratification: full-time faculty vote:

- *Minimum 25% of full time faculty must vote*
- *Two-thirds majority of faculty voting 'yea' or 'nay' by returned secret ballot*
- *At least 10 working days for balloting*

Bylaws changes automatically go into effect unless disapproved by the Board of Trustees within 90 days
