Program Suspension Proposal in CAMD

- MS-CPLD: Creative Practice Leadership, MS
 - The purpose of the suspension is to allow to critically examine issues in the current MS in Creative Practice Leadership (CPL) within the College of Arts, Media, and Design (CAMD), and consider what remedies are possible, or otherwise to move eliminate the program with the possibility of folding this degree as a track or concentration into another degree.
 - The proposal is supported the Associate Dean of Graduate Programs Casper Harteveld and Dean of CAMD Elizabeth Hudson. The proposal and intention to suspend enrollments has been shared with Finance, Enrollment, & Marketing.

Amendments to the Faculty Senate Bylaws

Faculty Senate:

- Must be distributed twice to the Senate and faculty prior to vote
- During Senate floor debate on an amendment proposal(s), Robert's Rules of Order apply for proposing amendments to any main motion, making advance notice not required
- A 2/3 affirmative vote of all Senators voting 'yea' or 'nay' in a roll-call vote

Ratification: full-time faculty vote:

- Minimum 25% of full time faculty must vote
- Two-thirds majority of faculty voting 'yea' or 'nay' by returned secret ballot
- At least 10 working days for balloting

Bylaws changes automatically go into effect unless disapproved by the Board of Trustees within 90 days
